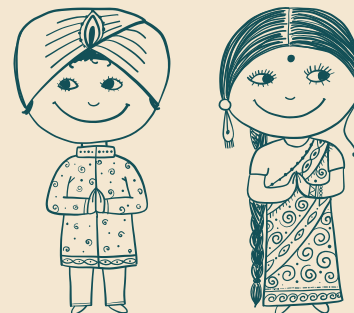

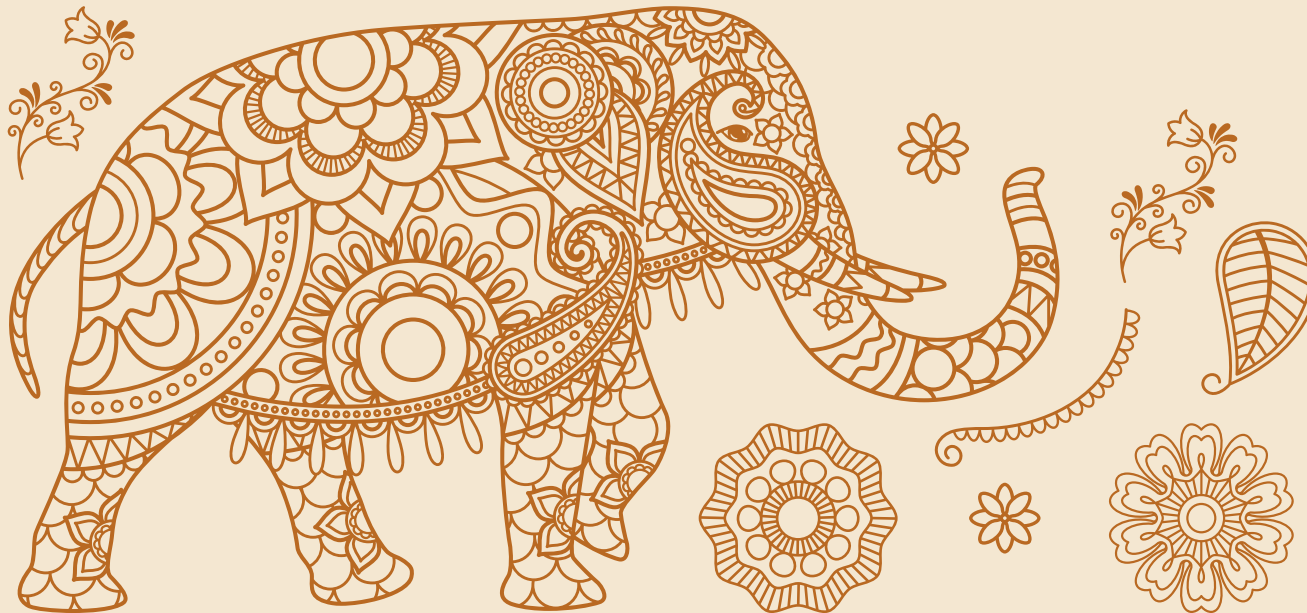
Top 10 Facts About India
